- Switch to Organic (OMRI Certified... Instead of Synthetic/Chemical Derived) (Includes Bagged Soil)
- Refrain Any Fertilizer (with Nitrogen and Phosphorus) Application from June to September (stormwater runoffs) to reduce algae growth and for cleaner water
