- Mid-March_ Resident geese begin nesting by Small and Large Lobe and on Island
- March 25_ Planted Tree and Shrub saplings by Pond

April (ongoing)

- * Water Supply on timer
- * Continue Skimming Small Lobe
- * Begin Skimming_Large Lobe
- * Test_ Apply Alternative Beneficial Bacteria_ Large Lobe center_ 04/01
- Trim and treat popcorn new growth
- Several Fish Spawning (by tall bridge and small lobe)
- April week of 10th, sighting of 5 goslings (as of 04/18, only 3 goslings)

Projections for May and Summer months...

- * Apply New Beneficial Bacteria
- * Apply HP Algaecide 'systematically/ rigorously'
- * Continue Skimming (request for committed 1~3 volunteers who could withstand strenuous task for 2 hours); comfortable staying the pond with critters, heavy lifting
